 Dry, fresh and clean with a harmonious and pleasantly vivacious palate. *glass* £ 7.50
 It has intense characteristic fragrances of acacia and wisteria flowers. Apples, pears and apricots.
- 61 Sergio Rose Mionetto (Italy)** £ 35.00
 It has a brilliant peach flower colour with a rich mousse. Its wonderful aromas stem *glass* £ 7.50
 from grapefruit raspberry strawberry blueberry and wild rose.
- 62 Louis Roederer Brut Premier (Champagne, France)** £ 65.00
 A stunning honeyed, creamy, biscuity full-bodied champagne; a blend of pinot noir *glass* £ 13.00
 and chardonnay, with a dollop of pinot meunier. A truly great champagne.

Intensely crisp, green fruit & aromas along with intense tropical passion fruit notes. ½ Carafe £18.00
It's fruity & has an intense smell but a fairly light body.
- 6 Waters Edge Pinot Grigio (Australia)** gls £ 6.50
Pale lemon colour with aromas of citrus fruits muted with subtle floral notes. ½ Carafe £17.00
Crisp & refreshing with citrus & green apple – Superb flavour & length.
- 7 Mamora Vermentino di Sardegna (Sardinia)** gls £ 7.00
Fresh and flinty with good mineral notes Rich bouquet with a hint of bitter almond and zest. ½ Carafe £19.00

White Wines

Dry & Refreshing

- 1 Mamaku Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough (New Zealand)** £27.00
Intensely crisp, green fruit & aromas along with intense tropical passion fruit notes. It's fruity & has an intense smell but a fairly light body.
- 2 Muscadet De Sevre et Maine Sur Lie A.C. (Loire, France)** £ 27.00
The Wine must be one of the best Muscadet's available – a wine of real finesse. Fresh, crisp Dry fruit bottled straight off it's 'lees' giving a slight tingle on the tongue and a long, clean flavour.
- 3 Conde Villar Alvarinho (Vinho Verde, Portugal)** £ 30.00
This white wine has generous aromas and flavours of peaches, lemons and orange blossom. It's full-bodied with a soft, creamy mouth feel and a pleasant finish.
- 4 Marco Bonfante Gavi di Gavi (Veneto, Italy)** £ 35.00
Apples and blossom on the nose, steely and elegant on the palate. Refreshing acidity and a pleasant length. Harmonious and persistent flavours.
- 5 Chablis Domaine Seguinot bordet (Burgundy, France)** £ 37.00
Very pretty pale golden yellow colour with greenish glints, the taste is perfect harmony of maturity, Mellowness and vivacity, flowers and fruit reappear, enhanced by charming biscuit notes.

Crisp & Fruity

- 6 Waters Edge - Pinot Grigio (Australia)** £ 25.00
Pale lemon colour with aromas of citrus fruits and green apple. Superb flavour and length.
- 7 Mamora Vermentino di Sardegna (Sardinia)** £ 27.00
Fresh and flinty with good mineral notes Rich bouquet with a hint of bitter almond and zest.
- 8 Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac (Pyrenees / France)** £ 28.00
Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, with a crisp mineral palate.
- 9 Lunate Fiano Terre Siciliane (Italy)** £ 31.00
This beautiful Fiano is nutty and textured with floral and honeyed notes, spice and tropical fruit flavours like pineapple.
- 10 Spring Creek Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough NZ)** £ 36.00
Bursting with gooseberry, asparagus and ripe melon. This really is a class act from a top Marlborough winery.

Aromatic & Fragrant

- 11 Cousino Macul Chardonnay (Chile)** £ 26.00
A remarkable un oaked wine, grown on soil rich in limestone. Pale, straw, gold in colour. Intensely fragrant, dry, fresh, smooth, balanced and complex.
- 12 H de L'Hospitalet Viognier (Languedoc-Roussillon, France)** £ 28.00
A delightful wine with an appealing spicy, floral and peachy nose. It is rich and ripe in the mouth yet has subtle apricot notes overlaid with a touch of spice and delicate oaky nuances.
- 13 Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt - Riesling (Germany)** £ 35.00
Peach, cassis and and grapefruit fragrances. Perfect balance of sweetness and acidity. A lively and appealing Riesling.
- 14 A²O Albariño 'Sobre Lias' (Pontevedra, Spain)** £ 36.00
The Wine goes through an extended aging process, enhancing the character and complexity, taking additional nutrients from the yeast, further enhancing the depths of the fruit flavours within the Albariño Grape variety
- 15 Knightor - Madeleine Angevine (Trethurgy, Cornwall)** £ 39.00
An elegant wine with delicate floral aromas, reminiscent of gooseberry & elderflower, finished off with a light refreshing plate.

Fine & Rare

- 16 Sancerre Domaine du P'tit Roy (Loire, France)** £ 43.00
A wine with truly outstanding depth of taste and richness. Crisp, lively and exhilarating.
- 17 Rully Blanc Les Villeranges (Burgundy, France)** £ 55.00
Gold winner at sommelier wine awards 2015. A rich, sumptuous off-dry Chenin Blanc. A wine of taste & delicious extremes – peach kernel, beeswax & spicy nutmeg on the nose. Powerful entry onto the palate with nuances of stone fruit, green apple & vanilla finish.
- 18 Chablis Premier Cru Fourchaume 2013/14 (Burgundy, France)** £60.00
Possibly the 'Premier of the Premiers', classic Chablis — Complex minerals, with flowery notes, marvellous acidity to balance the intense fruits.
- 19 Chassagne- Montrachet 2012 (Cote De Beaune, France)** £ 75.00
Hand harvested, the wine produced at Domaine Roux combine age-old traditions with today's most advanced technologies. Aged in oak barrels for between 13-14 months. Mature, complex and sophisticated with depth and character - ripe yellow and green fruits, good spice and a touch of blossom.

Rosé Wines

41 *Grís de Grenache des Coteaux de l' Ardeche* (France) £ 26.00

Bright rose petal hues, with a delicate aromatic bouquet of red fruits, and an elegant dry palate with fresh balance. Easy drinking.

42 *Cabernet Sauvignon Rosado* (Navarra, Spain) £ 27.00

A luscious, easy drinking rose with amazing raspberry and summer fruit flavours. Well balanced with pronounced Cabernet characteristics. A style, demanding glass after glass.

43 *Whispering Angel* (Provence, France) £ 52.00

An irresistible salmon colour. Charming, refreshing, refined, with plenty of juicy, enticing strawberry and berry fruit. The wine is expansive on the mid-palate, and has long, clean, fresh finish.

44 *Pinot Bacchus 2014* (Loos Valley Vineyards) £ 38.00

Established in 2009, husband & wife team started to aim for a high quality artisan wine. The Pinot gives the wine its fruity palate/nose & the bold deep pink colour. The Bacchus, being a the most popular of grapes to be grown by the British, brings the wine a balanced acidity & a sharp zing to lift the entire wine.

Red Wines

Light, fruity Reds

100 *Villa de Fiori Montepulciano d'Abruzzo* (Italy) £ 25.00

This Montepulciano from Abruzzo is deep ruby red with violet hues. Intense aromas, bursting with cherry fruit and a refreshing acidity.

101 *Pinot Noir La Clé Saint-Pierre Mommessin* (France) £ 32.00

Perfectly balanced and structured wine, with aromas of cherry, raspberry and blackcurrant. Rich and supple with soft tannins exhibiting good lasting fruit flavour.

102 *Fleurie Domaine de la Presle Mommessin* (France) £ 35.00

The 'Queen' of Beaujolais wines. Elegant, full bodied and velvety smooth. Delightfully fragrant, with aromas of violets, roses and iris, together with a garnet colour.

103 *Josef Chromy Pinot Noir* (Tasmania) £ 45.00

This wonderful Pinot Noir from Australia's coolest wines regions, Violets and crushed red berries hints of Vanilla characterise this stunning wine. Fresh, fruity concentrated finish.

Medium-bodied & Soft Reds

104 *Bush Telegraph Shiraz-Viognier* £ 27.00

A fantastic combination of peppery Australia Shiraz & perfumed Viognier. A great 'foodie' wine, as the meaty structure means it can pair well with steak & mature cheeses

105 *Peacock Ridge Merlot* (Stellenbosch, RSA) £ 28.00

A hugely aromatic and appealing Merlot with upfront dark black fruit. It has a touch of mocha, liquorice and tar, balanced by fine yet seductive tannins.

106 *Fazio Syrah, Luce D'Oriente* (Sicily, Italy) £ 34.00

A beautiful Italian Shiraz with a delicate bouquet of red berries and vanilla. Full, soft, velvety flavours that have hints of fruit and spices.

107 *Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Crianza* (Rioja, Spain) £ 35.00

This is a wine with a concentrated of red fruit flavour from the ripe Tempranillo as well as integrated spice, vanilla & a light toastiness, for a long elegant finish.

Full Bodied & Powerful Reds

- 108 Don Nicanor Malbec 2012/13 (Mendoza, Argentina) £ 35.00**
Deep, dark black berry fruit and damson mingle with earthy mocha and vanilla on the nose. The palate is smooth and rounded with supple tannins and a long, intense finish.
- 109 Villa Belvedere Valpolicella Ripasso (Veneto, Italy) £38.00**
This wine has distinctive aromas of cherry jam, with some notes of vanilla and balsamic vinegar too. It is a rich, full-bodied wine with dried fruit and black pepper on the palate.
- 110 Journey's End Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 (Stellenbosch S.A) £40.00**
The depth & structure of this Cabernet Sauvignon is the result of a very soft & delicate. However do not let this deceive you as the power comes with the finish. Planted in 1998, the result is a superb red, like a fist in a velvet glove.
- 111 Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Reserva 2008 (Rioja, Spain) £42.00**
Intense cherry red, with aromas of Parma violets, red fruits, vanilla & spice. This wine is a selection of Tempranillo and Graciano grape that has been aged for 24 months in French and American Oak Barrels.
- 112 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Berhet-Rayne 2011 (Rhône) £55.00**
This is an impressive organic production, with a deep colour. A full body wine from oak casting giving a good balance between the wood and concentrated notes of black cherries and rich fruits.

Fine & Rare

- 113 Chateau Barrail du Blanc. St Emilion Grand Cru A.C 2008 £45.00**
A well bred wine with character and excellent balance. Exceptionally rich wine with ripe bouquet and complex tannins. Rich and subtle
- 114 Vietti Nebbiolo Perbacco 2012 (Italy) £62.00**
Offers up generous fruit along with menthol, spices and hard candy, showing notable intensity while retaining an essentially mid-weight style. Strong, intense and powerful when young, complex and elegant with the ageing.
- 115 Circumstance Syrah 2009 - (Stellenbosch, RSA) £65.00**
This dark rich wine with hints of sweet spices and black fruit aromas. Has a vanilla and cocoa palate, that is velvety in taste with lasting notes.
- 116 Paul Jaboulet Aîné Crozes Hermitage Rouge 2012 (Rhône) £75.00**
The wine has very spicy, rich, dark fruit flavours and aromas. Intense, complex and aromatic with red berry flavours. Powerful and fine, with a full, well-balanced finish.
- 117 Domaine Lignier Morey-Saint-Denis 2012 (Burgundy, France) £85.00**
Morey remains one of Burgundy's lesser known gems. Enjoy the seductively silky, yet muscular, dense fruit of this top vintage village red from a renowned family domaine. Strawberry and violet aromas with a hint of spice, superb depth of firm red fruits and truffle notes wrapped in a cloak of tannins. A perfect, age-worthy addition to the cellar.

- 201 Essensia Orange Muscat (USA)** 375ml £ 35.00
With an aroma of orange blossom and apricots, the palate is rich and sweet.
With vibrant peachy and orangey fruit, ending with a lingering refreshing aftertaste 100ml £ 7.00
- 202 Vendima Tardía De Chardonnay (Spain)** 500ml £ 36.00
The quality of this wine allows it's marriage to be versatile. Can be enjoy alongside
Fois Gras, but especially with biscuit & pastry based dishes. 100ml £ 8.00
- 203 Elysium Black Muscat (USA)** 375ml £ 37.50

Full bodied vintage port with a deep ruby colour and a rich velvety palate
Ideally served with soft, blue or cured cheeses. Also many crème desserts

Ramos Pinto White Reserva 50ml £ 7.00
Amber yellow colour, the nose is fine, intense and quite complex, blending tropical aromas with
crystallized orange, plus hints of balsam and spices. The palate is full bodied but elegant, well bal-
anced with a long lasting finish.

Ramos Pinto Late Bottled Vintage 2011 50ml £ 8.00
The extended period of wood maturation enables these fine wines to be drunk much earlier

Ramos Pinto Tawny 10 Year Old 50ml £ 10.00
Its brick-red, even golden shades transport us to the Orient of Spices, piquant & exotic aromas with,
