



## House Rules for Dogs

We do hope that you and your dog's enjoy our beautiful hotel and to assist you and our other guests to achieve this we do have a few reasonable requests to make of you, which in reality are really requirements, which, we are sure you will agree, will help to ensure that you, your furry friend and our other guests enjoy a relaxing stay.

- Firstly, please let us know, when booking, if you plan to invite your dog, so that we can prepare for their visit.
- On arrival guests with dogs will need to complete a dog registration form and contract and to agree to be responsible for any damage their dog may cause.
- If your dog does soil your room then, unfortunately, there will be a £200.00 room cleaning charge added to your bill. Other damage will be charged at cost.
- Your dogs are welcome to wander with you in the grounds throughout the day.
- Please ask your dog to converse in the same hushed tones that you and our other two-legged guests also employ around the hotel.
- There are bins around the grounds for you to deposit your dog's daily gifts to the lawns and there is a small supply of bags at reception should you forget your own or run out.
- Some of our guests, as you will know, are allergic to dog hair or are simply not as fond of our four legged friends as we are and do not like to see them on the seating in the lounge and nor in the dining rooms. Therefore, there is a supply of doggy blankets available at reception to protect the lounge furniture and we would ask you to collect one of these if you are going to invite your smaller dogs onto the seating. Larger dogs are welcome to curl up on the carpet.
- As you know not everyone enjoys a Canine Companion during meal times. For this reason we keep the Terrace restaurant as a 'dog free' area during service of all meals. You are welcome to dine with your dog in the Brasserie or the bar where dogs should be on the floor at all times.
- Our experience with dogs at Talland Bay is a very good one and little offence or damage is ever caused to anyone. We make a small paw print charge of £15.00 per dog, per night and for this small contribution your little friend will get a sausage breakfast and a chicken dinner whenever you dine with us.
- Please refrain from using the bath to clean your dog. There is an outside tap at the back of the resident's lounge.
- **Dogs should not be left in the room unattended for any length of time.**
